

SANITARY PROTOCOL

Given the constraints related to the COVID-19 protocol, please take note of the protocol below in application of decree n ° 2020-1035 of August 13, 2020
Modification of decree No.2020-860 of July 10, 2020

In every case, the physical distance of at least 1 meter between people and the wearing a mask must be strictly observed

1 - COVID-19 Team Leader

A COVID-19 Team is responsible on arrival for each team.

He must submit the questionnaire drawn up by the medical committee that you have received by email with this protocol

During the tournament directory, the health protocol will be explained and given to the COVID-19 team manager

He will receive the plan of the ice rink with the identified dedicated spaces and the circulation plan

He must take the temperature reading of all team members and hand in the form statement to the management board. The temperature must be less than 38 °. Anyone not responding to this requirement will be referred to a doctor and prohibited from participating in the event.

2- Wearing masks

Anyone 11 years old and over must wear a general public mask in enclosed public places, in addition to the application of barrier gestures. Only athletes are allowed not to wear masks during training and matches. This requires wearing a mask before and after the ice session. Therefore please provide as many masks as necessary.

- The players must go to the edge of the ice with the mask, remove it on order of coaches and place it in an identifiable personal object, no mask placed loose on the benches. At the end of the training put on the mask before going to the locker room.

3- Changing rooms

At the entrance to the changing rooms you will find on a table

- 1 non-contact forehead thermometer
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 trash can without lid

In the changing rooms, you must respect the markings put in place, i.e. every other place and in place of demarcation of showers of 1 of 2.

The changing rooms will be disinfected when there is a change of team in the changing room concerned

Hockey equipment may be stored in a room provided by the organizer.

For obvious hygiene reasons, remember to collect your pants, underwear, towel, jerseys, stockings etc

4- Phase of the match

A member of the scorer's table will be appointed by the organizer as the Covid Match Delegate, he must ensure that the points below are respected:

- Each member of the team (management, players, officials and referees) wears a mask permanently inside the Arena, including on the bench. Only the players in the game (players, coaches and referees) are authorized to remove them during the warm-up, match or toilet.
- Each member of the team (management and players) disinfects their hands with a hydro-alcoholic solution before and after each entry / exit to the changing rooms (arrival, 2 interludes, departure).
- Each player uses an identified and personalized pipette, whether in the locker room or on the bench. The people in charge of filling and / or disinfecting the pipettes wear gloves disposable latex. These gloves should be discarded immediately after each use.
- Each player keeps his helmet and gloves throughout the match.
- Rolls of paper towels will be placed on the team benches so that no one do not resort to the use of multipurpose towels.
- Fans or glove dryers are prohibited.
- Spitting and hugging are prohibited.
- No player in the game shakes hands (either before or after the game), hugs or shares a piece of equipment:
- No handshaking between referees and bench officials:
- Simple greeting while passing in front of each bench, while respecting the rules of distancing, starting with; visiting team
- No handshaking between referees and captains or between captains
- Simple greeting, respecting the rules of distancing
- No handshaking between the teams at the end of the match:
- Each of the actors leaves the mirror in the pre-defined order
- No hug between players (nor after a goal, nor to celebrate a victory)
- Players can, if they really want to, just check each other hand-to-hand by wearing their gloves
- No award ceremony for the best player of the match
- The linesmen do not pick up any pieces of equipment on the ice and invite the player concerned to come and collect it himself during a stoppage of play
- Pucks are stored in a bucket of ice at the penalty bench in which the same linesman will come and help himself during the match if necessary

- We provide individual 50cl water bottles at the penalty benches, one per penalized player, which must be withdrawn upon exiting.

Additional recommendations

- It is strongly recommended to perform 72 hours before your participation in a PCR test.
- Minimize the time spent on the match site (2 hours before and 1 hour after the match).
- Limit relations exclusively between members of his team.
- Respect barrier and distancing gestures
- The referees will be able to interact with the table officials and coaches in respecting the rules of distancing.
- Immediately report any actor showing a symptom to the match doctor and the COVID Match Delegate.

We reserve the right to exclude a player for the duration of the tournament, depending on his behavior linked to the different protocols.
